What is Advocacy?

Advocacy is:

- **about you** and your advocate **working together**
- about **working together** to get people to **listen to your views**
- **free**. It will **not cost** you anything
- when a person **helps you to be heard**

A 1-1 Advocate could help you to:

- Make informed **choices** about your housing needs.
- Understand **your rights and responsibilities** in any change of housing.
- Support to make **informed decisions** about your housing needs
- Be informed of **all the stages** of moving home.
- Understand the cost of moving and **make a budget**
- Support **during housing transitions**
- Support you to **speak up for yourself**
